Will the inspector: inform you about amateur workmanship or substandard maintenance, or advise when to consult an expert to look more closely at suspected problem areas?	YES	
Will the inspector: detail the maintenance for all the components of the house?	YES	
Will the inspector: list problems in major and minor groupings? (Major problems are defined as problems that cost \$1000 or more to repair or constitute a significant safety hazard)	YES
